Nursery Am - Autumn Term 1 2024

Communication and Language

This term we will be encouraging the children to listen and follow instructions. We will focus on extending their vocabulary and their understanding of simple concepts. The children will listen to a variety of stories and talk about their own ideas and feelings.

Physical

The children will have daily opportunities to develop their gross and fine motor skills, through activities inside the classroom, such as drawing, using scissors and manipulating play dough.

They will also have continuous access to the outdoor area throughout the year. The outdoor environment has climbing equipment, bikes, basketball hoop, balancing beams, balls, ribbons to name but a few.

Literacy

We will practise and develop our mark making using a range of different mediums, such as foam, pens, crayons, sand, paint and gloop.

We will be sharing a variety of stories and books with the children allowing them to become familiar with different pictures and words.

Through a range of activities children will raise their awareness of the sounds around them and will develop their listening skills.

PSED

This term we will be helping the children to settle into a routine in nursery and become confident in their key groups.

We will be talking to the children about using kind hands, feet and words while playing with their friends. During games, group time and play we will encourage turn taking.

Throughout the day children will be encouraged to become independent learners and to help each other. We will be learning how to put our coats and shoes on independently.

Maths

Children will learn number knowledge by singing counting songs/rhymes, reciting numbers in a sequence, looking at numbers and counting their fingers. They will explore number every day during their play.

We also will start to practise our subitising up to 3 (instantly being able to a small number of objects without having to count each one).

Outside there will be lots of opportunities to compare sizes and the capacity of different objects during water, sand and messy play. Inside we will explore and talk about size and shape during block play, junk modelling and playdough to name a few.

We will use our visual timetable to help us to understand what we have done and what we will do next. This will help us to begin to use time words (such as now, next, then,).

UW

This term we will be getting to know each other which will include talking about how we are similar and different. We will also be talking about our families and we will start to look at how we have changed since we were babies.

Whilst outside the children will also be encouraged to observe and talk about what is happening in the world around them including experiencing and talking about the changes in weather and seasons.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will engage in regular role play in our home corner and outside in our mud kitchen and building area. They will construct models out of different building materials and explore their creative ideas through the use of paints and collage materials in our Art area.

Our outdoor stage gives opportunities for the children to sing songs and make their own music with a variety of musical instruments. They will learn and perform familiar and new songs during group time.
