Maths:


Place Value within 20.

We will be discovering mechanisms to make a slider mechanism to create a matching slider game.


Computing:

Music:


The children will be introduced to sound patterns (rhythms). They will learn to create simple rhythmic patterns to tell a familiar fairytale.




