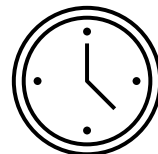
English:

3. Accents to show which vowels are stressed

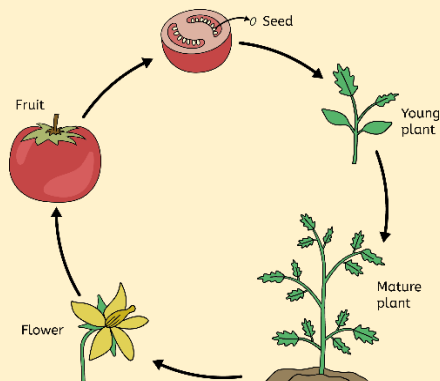
Geography - Europe:



- 1) Human features = made/built by humans.
- 2) Physical features = natural environment.
- 3) Tourism is the industry/business that provides goods and services for tourists.

Science - Plants:

- 1) Plants need oxygen, carbon dioxide, water, light, nutrients from the soil, space, and a suitable temperature to grow.
- 2) Pollination is the transfer of pollen from one plant to another.
- 3) Fertilisation forms a seed in a plant.



Art:

We will be using Plants to help us understand layers.

PSHE:

We will be learning about our relationships with our family and our global rights and responsibilities.

PE:

We will be learning how to play cricket.



Computing - Animation:

- 1) Animation = a sequence of drawings or photographs.
- 2) Each of the pictures in an animation is called a frame.
- 3) Stop-frame animation = lots of frames that change slightly in small increments.
- 4) When played back quickly, this makes it appear as though the images are moving / performing an action.
- 5) Onion skinning = showing the previous frame faintly to show you where to draw next.
- 6) Animations include characters, settings and events (just like a story!).

RE - Hinduism:

- 1) Hinduism is a religion.
- 2) Brahman is the supreme spirit and other gods in Hinduism are representations of Brahman.
- 3) A representation is a picture or likeness of another thing.

Music: Jazz
